## **DEATH OF MRS H. C. HAILE.**

**Springfield Woman Was Wife of  
Son of Late Lieut Gov W. H.  
Haile.**

SPRINGFIELD, April 2.—Mrs Henry C. Haile, aged 31, wife of the son of the late Lieut Gov William H. Haile, died today at her home, 23 Edwards st. of pneumonia after a few days' illness.

Mrs Haile's maiden name was Elizabeth Pennington. She was the daughter of Mr and Mrs Josias Pennington of Baltimore, Md, where she was born in 1877. The family is one of the oldest in Baltimore. Mrs Haile's brother, Yetes Pennington, married a former Springfield girl, Genevieve Thompson, daughter of the late Col J. M. Thompson. Miss Pennington married Mr Haile in 1901, and at once moved to this city, where she has been prominent in social circles.

Mrs Haile leaves beside her husband, a five-year-old son, Henry Pennington Haile, three brothers, Josias, Harry and Yetes Pennington, and a sister, Miss Sophia C. Pennington. Services will be held at the house tomorrow afternoon, Rev Dr C. L. Slattery of Christ church officiating, and the body will be taken to Baltimore for burial after services held in the Brown Memorial church, Rev Dr Stone of Baltimore having charge.
