

DR. G. A. GATES DIES FROM WRECK INJURY

Dr. George A. Gates, who until a month ago was president of Flisk university, a brother-in-law of Stanley G. Smith of this city, died yesterday at Winter Park, Fla. His death was the result of injuries received in the wreck on the Pennsylvania railroad at Huntington, Pa., last April.

At first it was not believed that Dr. Gates was seriously hurt, but inside of a month his condition became serious. He was forced to give up his position as president of the negro university, and was told to take a trip to some place where he could get absolute rest.

Dr. Gates was married to Miss Isabelle Smith, daughter of Stias F. Smith of this city, in 1882. Beside his wife he is survived by two sons, Stanley Gates of Chicago, Ill., and Donald Smith Gates of Iowa college.
